

## **Best of Besilu Classes**

Besilu Collection will offer two "Best of Besilu" classes awarding a total of \$28,750.00 in prize money. There will be a conformation class and an under saddle "Paso Fino Class". The conformation class will offer a total of \$9,400.00. Prize money will be broken out as follows: 1st place: \$5,000.00; 2nd place: \$2,500.00; 3rd place: \$1,000.00; 4th place: \$500.00; 5th place: \$250.00; 6th place: \$100.00 and 7th place: \$50.00. This class will follow the procedures of a Bellas Formas class. The saddle class will offer a total purse of \$19,350.00. Prize money will be broken out as follows: 1st place: \$10,000.00; 2nd place: \$5,000.00; 3rd place: \$2,500.00; 4th place: \$1,000.00; 5th place: \$500.00; 6th place: \$250.00; 7th place: \$100.00. All of the horses bought from Besilu Collection in 2009 will have a chance to compete one time in each class. For example, a yearling may compete in the conformation class in April of 2010 and then compete under saddle one time at a future class. Older horses may also compete in the conformation class one time and again under saddle one time.

The Best of Besilu classes will be held at Besilu Collection in Micanopy, FL (Marion County, with zip code 32667 – just 18 miles north of Ocala) April 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010 as part of the Besilu Spring Stallion Exhibition and Sale that will be held every year beginning in 2010. The conformation class will follow the procedure of a Bellas Formas class. The horses will be judged on the line, based on their overall conformation and breeding qualities as well as their quality of the Paso Fino gait.

The saddle class is a Paso Fino class. The horses will be judged in the Paso Fino gait, regardless of the show division the horse competes in. They will be judged on the quality and clarity of gait, conformation, and way of going as well as breeding qualities. The horses will perform at only one speed. The horses will be asked to do individual tests. The horses will be judged on their performance for the day in Paso Fino gait. They will be evaluated on their quality and clarity of gait, conformation, and way of going, and breeding qualities. It does not matter whether the horse is shown in Classic Fino, Performance or Pleasure. The horse will perform in only one speed. The horses will be asked to do individual tests and the 5 judge system will be used. The judges for the 2010 Best of Besilu Classes are: Carmen Cepero, Rick Meyer, Nicanor Miranda, Wilman Rodriguez and Jorge Suarez.

Money prizes will be awarded immediately after the class.

The owners of horses sold by Besilu Collection in 2009 will be notified to find out if they will be participating in either class. Each owner will receive an information packet with all of the entry requirements.

### **BEST OF BESILU ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Horse was sold by Besilu Collection during a qualifying calendar year.
- Horse can only compete one time in the conformation class and one time in the saddle class.
- There is no entry fee.

- If the horse transfers ownership, the eligibility transfers to the new owner. Please provide Besilu Collection with new owner details so we can forward the entry packet to them.
- Horse must have current negative coggins and health paper (if out of state) in order to enter show grounds or the Besilu Farm.

Horses being sold by Besilu Collection in 2010 are eligible to compete in the 2011 Best of Besilu Classes. Besilu Collection is very excited about this new program and hopes that you will take full advantage of our sales and financing program, so that you realize your dreams of a Besilu horse, and have a chance to recoup some of your investment.
